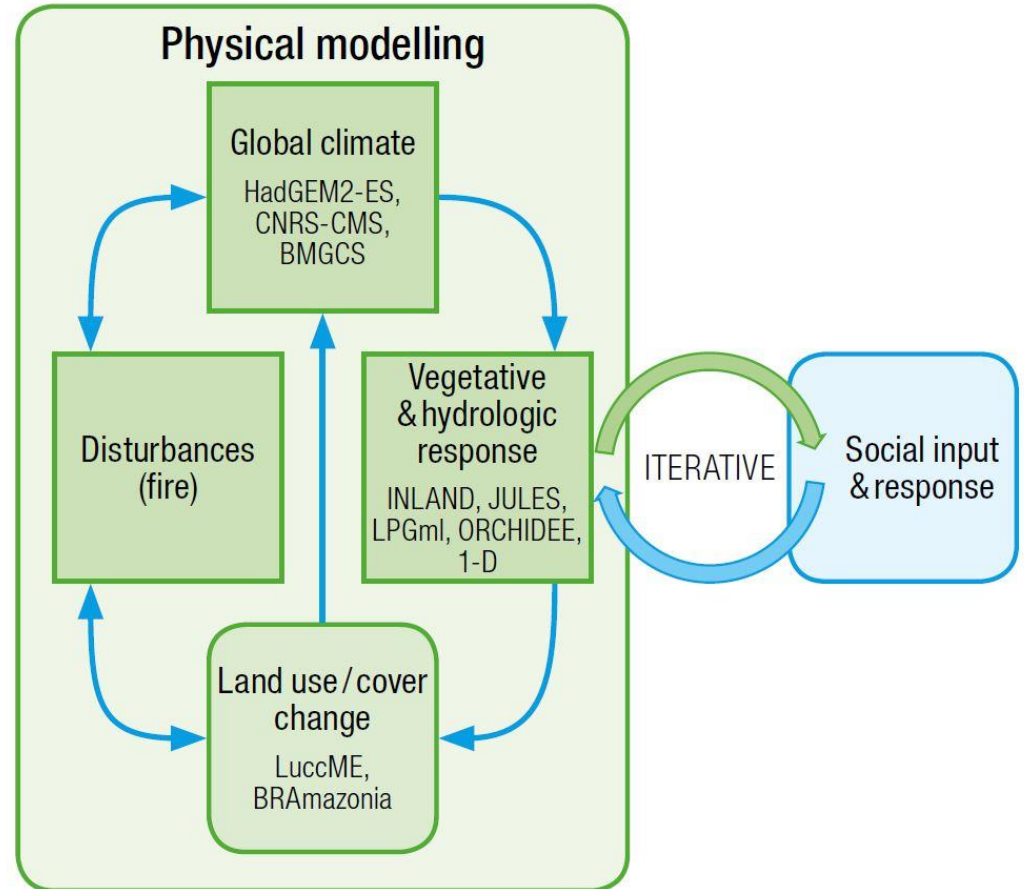

Background - Scenarios and policies (WP4)

Objectives:

- Develop a set of qualitative and quantitative land use scenarios using participative methods.

Background -Workshops in Brazil

Main characteristics:

- Two workshops were organised in Brazil:
 - 25-26 June, Belém. Civic society and business participants
 - 25 November, Brasilia. Government and science.
- Main aims:
 - First: Draft scenarios for Brazilian Amazon (What could happen?)
 - Second: Add trajectories (How can that happen?)
- Main output:
 - Land use change scenarios
 - Maps of patterns of land use change



Objectives of this workshop

DISSEMINATION. To present the main results from other parts of Amazalert and of the first workshop(s) in Brazil.

DEVELOP OVERVIEW OF CURRENT POLICIES related to deforestation in the Amazon. What is the current role of European policies?
